

Grading Criteria for Music (Grades K-8)

1. Coming Prepared for Class Grades 3-8 (student materials and instruments):

IF A STUDENT COMES UNPREPARED FOR CLASS, HE/SHE WILL BE GIVEN A MARK ON HIS/HER DETENTION SLIP.

2. Written Assignments:

- worksheets
- timed music readings
- timed rhythm readings
- quizzes and tests
- aural skills (listening)

3. Demonstrations (scheduled date):

4. Group Projects (prepared during class time):

5. Participation (effort, conduct and following directions in class):
